

Parish Concludes Busy Year in 2024

The year 2024 proved to be another busy one for St. Stephen the Martyr, as the calendar showed very little mercy for events and activities.

We will reserve the important details for the Annual Parish Meeting at the end of January, but the highlights of this year included the following events.

February saw the traditional Lenten Soup Suppers commence on Wednesdays before Stations of the Cross Services. This included a highly successful fish fry during that time.

The faithful began in ernest, pierogimaking for the annual picnic with sessions in March, April and May. All agreed it beat the hot weather sessions that were typical in the past.

Picnic plans continued throughout the summer, and despite moving from St. Benedict's Grove to Willow Glen Park, the event was once again successful. There were some lessons to be learned,

but once again, most agreed the changes were worth the effort.

Jay Rowe received the financial report from Joe Faranda, and the records revealed that the 2024 event was comparable to the last few years, perhaps slightly above the year prior.

The major change for 2025, as voted upon by the parish, would be to move the picnic to Saturday. This is due to an overlap with the venue's weekly flea market on Sundays. While the date switch adds a bit of uncertainty to the matter, it was agreed that the change would make the event run much

The balance of the year included all of the usual events and activities, including the celebration and commemoration of Memorial Day, Veterans Day, All Souls Day, Thanksgiving, and the Advent and Christmas seasons.

The parish was also busy with the celebration services of First Holy Communion and Confirmation.

A last minute Polish Food Sale was held in time for Christmas Celebration. A dedicated work crew made a batch of pierogies for our own members.
